**On Friday, June 9<sup>th</sup>, we bought the following dog food at OBI:**

- 24 cans of Pedigree for puppies (400 gr each)
- 10 cans of Pedigree for adults (1.2 kg each)
- 4 bags of Chappi & Pedigree dry food (15 kg each)

**On Sunday, June 11<sup>th</sup>, we bought the following items at the Beethoven pet store on Leninsky Prospekt (the dog food was cheaper at OBI, but prices for cat food are better at Beethoven):**

- 24 cans of Kitekat Chicken for cats (400 gr each)
- 24 cans of Kitekat Rabbit for cats (400 gr each)
- 24 cans of Kitekat Liver for cats (400 gr each)
- 24 cans of Kitekat Tuna for cats (400 gr each)
- 24 cans of Kitekat Beef for cats (400 gr each)
- 2 boxes of dry Proplan Cat Chow for kittens
- 2 boxes of dry Friskies for kittens
- 18 bags of dry food for adult cats (Darling, Kitekat & Whiskas)
- 10 toy mice for the cat shelters
- One 15-kg bag of Hills Prescription Diet i/d for Katia's 14-year-old rescued Labrador Dana

The cat food has been divided into two equal portions. Half will go to Lyuba's cat shelter in Vykhino (Tonda Zimmerman has kindly agreed to arrange delivery), and half to Tatiana's cat shelter in Altufyevo. Tonda had also offered to delivery the dog food to Katia's shelter, but as we rescued an abandoned Mittelschnauzer with Katia's help on Tuesday evening, June 13<sup>th</sup>, we delivered the food to her straight away.
